

DO YOU HOLD AN ELECTORAL IDENTITY CARD?

An Electoral Identity Card is one of the seven forms of photographic identity which the law in Northern Ireland requires you to produce.

The Electoral Identity Card is accepted as proof of identify or age by:

Banks and building societies when opening a bank account

UK Airline (for domestic flights to and from Northern Ireland

How do you apply for a card?

Application may be made either by post or in person at an Area Electoral Office. To obtain a card you must be listed on the Electoral Register or have applied to be registered.
